Honors/level 2 classes differ from level 1 classes in that the course objectives tend to be more complex and are to be accomplished at a more rapid pace. Moreover, the in-class activities and assignments require greater complexity of thought, a greater degree of independent inquiry and a greater degree of sophistication in writing, research, and problemsolving skills. A total of 35 different honors/level 2 courses are available each school year.



HOOL DISTRICT INFORMATION

ering an area of 393 square miles, Hall County Schools serves the educational needs of Flowery Branch, Oakwood, and all county areas outside the city limits of Gainesville, rgia (which is served by a city school system with one high school). Our county is about an hour's drive from Atlanta and Athens and is located in the northeastern part of state. Currently, the district has eight high schools, nine middle schools, and twenty elementary schools. Schools are organized in a K-5, 6-8, 9-12 configuration.

In addition, IB oloma students must participate in a iety of creativity, activity, and service periences and complete a CAS project last more than one month. IB Diploma idents must also complete the tended Essay, a 4000 word research per on the topic of their choice. idents are allowed to participate in lividual IB coursework in any area with wo-year course commitment.

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) **COURSEWORK**

Students can chose from over ten AP courses to increase the rigor of their core curriculum at NHHS. North Hall High School has earned the designation as a 2020 AP STEM School and a 2020 AP STEM Achievement School.

ATLAS PROGRAM

The ATLAS program is designed for for ninth and tenth-grade students ready for academic rigor, leadership opportunities, and experiences. It offers a well-rounded curriculum of advanced educational opportunities in all content areas. Students are offered a program of study that ensures a challenging curriculum to prepare them for both college and career. Learning experiences are integrated to build inquiring, compassionate, and life-long learners. Candidates are selected based on demonstrated achievement, motivation to excel, collaboration and leadership abilities, and service within the community

STEM ACADEMY

The STEM Academy at North Hall High School is a program designed for students with interests and aptitude in Science, Technology, Engineering and/or Mathematics. The STEM Academy is a technologyrich environment where students are encouraged to recognize and develop connections between content areas using real-world problems as a basis for learning.

ONLINE LEARNING

GA Virtual School is an online, fully accredited Georgia Charter School. GAVS is used on a limited basis to expand high school offerings during the regular school day at no charge to the student.

The Hall County Blended Learning Academy is an online program which offers additional Health/Personal Fitness, Modern Language (Spanish and Mandarin Chinese) classes to Hall County students as part of the seven period day or as an additional class at home at no charge to the student.
